

# 84 INTERNATIONAL BRASS QUINTET FESTIVAL & SYMPOSIUM

The International Brass Quintet Festival was established in 1980 as the only festival of its kind, and has become one of the most important summer cultural events in the Eastern United States. The month-long Festival presents the world's finest brass quintets in a series of public concerts, and provides a serious forum for brass players through its intensive symposium in brass chamber performance. 400 years of brass music will be performed in the more than twenty-five concerts during the Festival.

The INTERNATIONAL BRASS QUINTET FESTIVAL is hosted by its RESIDENT ENSEMBLE, the internationally acclaimed ANNAPOLIS BRASS QUINTET, and this year will feature two distinguished GUEST ENSEMBLES: The ARBAN BRASS QUINTET from Dijon, France, and Philadelphia's CHESTNUT BRASS COMPANY.

## 1984 International Brass Quintet Symposium Application & Information:

The International Brass Quintet Festival's ten day Symposium for brass players will be held Tuesday, July 10 through Thursday, July 19, 1984. Garrison Forest School, located in the lush rolling hills surrounding Baltimore, is the site of the Symposium. A total of twenty-five participants will be selected. Applicants may apply as individuals or quintets. The Symposium will include concerts, master classes and open rehearsals by the ANNAPOLIS BRASS QUINTET, the ARBAN BRASS QUINTET and the CHESTNUT BRASS COMPANY. The Symposium quintets will be coached daily by members of the ANNAPOLIS BRASS QUINTET and each quintet will perform a concert as part of the International Brass Quintet Festival.

### Application is open to:

1. Brass quintets
2. Incomplete quintets (individual applicants will be selected to complete ensemble)
3. Individual brass players (those selected will perform in quintets formed for the symposium)

### To apply send:

1. 5-10 minute tape recording (open reel or cassette) of your ensemble. (Individual applicants, 5-10 minutes of solo performance).
2. A short resumé of each player (age, education, playing experience).
3. Repertoire list, or concert programs—if available. (Not applicable to individuals).
