1976 First brass performance in Vienna's Brahmsaal  
First of 6 summer residencies at Artpark, NY  
1977 First of 3 summer residencies in Norway  
1978 Won Munich Critics Award, recorded with Bavarian Radio Orchestra  
1979 American Music Festival, Portugal  
NEA grant for Maryland residency, first adult workshops  
1980 BCMSA was established - first ABQ Artists series  
First concerts in Hawaii & Guatemala  
1981 First tour of Orient  
Established IBQF - Guest group: Ensemble Prisma-Vienna  
1982 Toured Europe for 10th time  
1983 Around the World Tour; Kennedy Center performance  
1984 First brass performance at 92nd St. Y, NYC

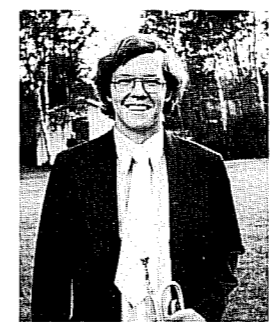

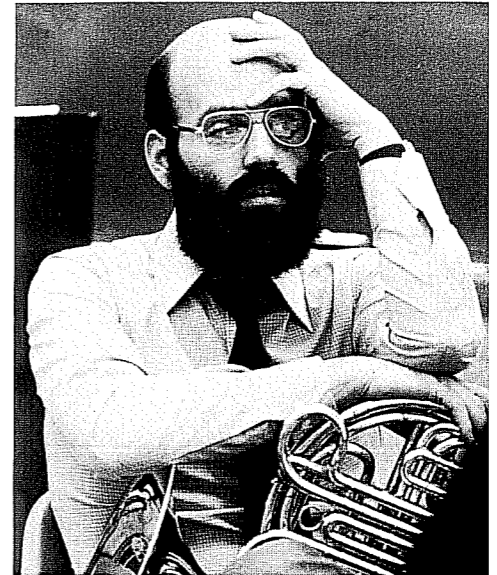

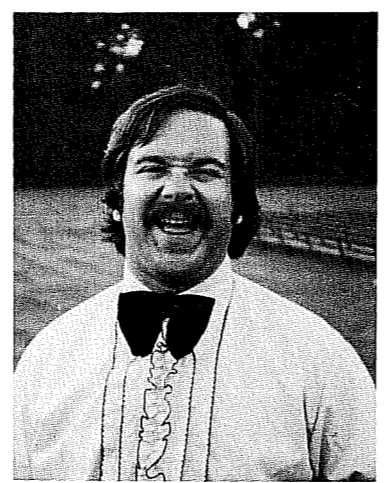
